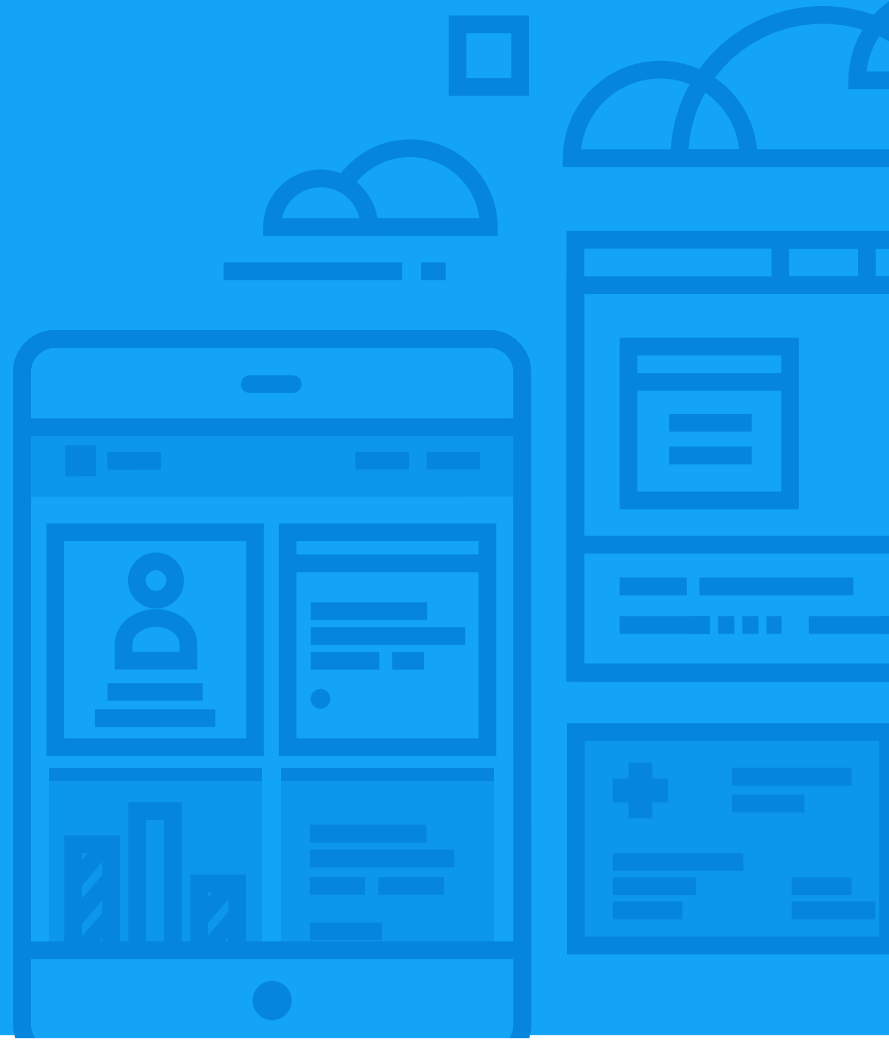


# Transforming the healthcare GL


